"I understand the usage policies of the Beulah Baptist Association Shower Trailer, I agree to the following terms."

- A \$125 usage fee will be charged for usage of trailer.
- The trailer will be loaned out after calling and scheduling a pre-approved event with the Beulah Baptist Executive Officers, and Beulah's Churches having priority over neighboring associations.
- **An Instructional meeting must be attended prior to use of the trailer.**
- A good policy would be to reserve the shower trailer 2-3 months in advance.
- This fee is ONLY refundable if inclement weather prevents use of the scheduled event.
- **You will be responsible for having a 2500-3500 Heavy Duty Truck to pull this trailer.**
- A Beulah associate will come to the location to see that it has been set up properly & return to the site prior to the trailer being returned to see that it is cleaned and nothing broken (if possible).
- The user is responsible for cleaning **all** stalls, sinks, floors and not leaving any garbage.
- In case of an insurance claim the user will be responsible for the deductible if for some reason Beulah's insurance is used.
- All checks are to be made payable to Beulah Baptist Association.

"I have read, understand, and agree to abide by the policies governing use of the Evangelistic Shower Trailer. I further agree to operate all equipment according to their individual instructions," I hereby release Beulah Baptist Association from any liability due to hookup, transportation and usage.

Beulah Baptist Shower Trailer is equipped with 6 private stalls, sinks and lights.

It houses a 100 lb Propane tank (caged on the tongue of trailer) that runs the endless hot water for each unit.

30 amp electrical unit available with adapter, HOWEVER, **a 110-30 amp plug in receptacle is advised**

This trailer is equipped with air conditioning and Manuel Pop up air vents.

Entry Doors are 30" wide, 7" high into rooms.

You will be responsible for your own toiletries, soap and towels.

Please do not leave any extras on trailer when finished.

HOW TO SET UP AND USE:

- 1 -Plug into power source – use ONLY a 110-30 amp receptacle (1st choice) or the 30 amp adapter
- 2- Turn on A/C in ceiling of storage compartment
- 3- Open drain plugs – attach short drain hoses and open valves on side – pull hoses away from trailer to drain any grey water
- 4- Hook up to water source with faucet valve open all the way
- 5- Turn on Hot H2O source by turning valve to the right (turn down to close)
- 6- Turn on gas tank valve (the one on front side NOT the top) all the way
- 7- Turn on sink at far end to blow out air line (make sure not to leave on after set up)
- 8- Turn on thermostat in #8 stall to 110 (must close door to see reading) – NO ONE UNDER 18

TO CLOSE UP:

Reverse all steps above – open a sink before unhooking water hose from trailer to prevent spray then turn off. When replacing plugs on drains make sure small round plug is at bottom.

Beulah Baptist is so happy to have this top of the line Shower Trailer for use with Mission teams, our own churches and neighboring associations. We are thankful that the majority of the cost of this shower trailer was made available by an anonymous donor. For this reason that the Lord has gifted this to Beulah please help us be good stewards of this new trailer with lots of TLC.
