Our Adult/Youth Venture was a great success. 15 of our Beulah Churches & one from MS consisting of 176 folks in-  
vaded Muscogee, OK, June 22nd through June 27th. We are already looking forward to next year's trip June 21st-June

June 17th my mother in law went to be with the Lord. I always called her "Mammie". I marvel at how she raised ten chil-  
dren on very limited funds, all of which are still alive. Her greatest asset, she loved every child, grandchild, great grand-  
child & great-great grandchild the same. Her legacy- 10 children, nineteen grandchildren, twenty-six great grandchildren  
& eight great-great grandchildren so far. She was a simple woman with a heart as big as Texas. She will be missed.

Thanks to Blake Grey and Woodland Mills for working with me to complete a wheelchair ramp at 3505 clear Brooke  
Dr. Woodland Mills. The family consist of man & woman in their late 60's. He's wheelchair bound and she is legally  
blind.

Welcome to Bro. Jeremy Powell and his wife, Jodi, & girls, Emma & Abbi, as they begin their ministry at Crosswind  
Baptist Church. The Powell's come to us from Hayden, AL where Jeremy served as served as Senior Pastor for 6 ½ years.

## Hello Beulah:

Summer is in full swing along with our mission endeavors. What a wonderful time we have had so far in serving The Lord together in Beulah.

We had a mission team in June that came and stayed in Lake County. They did construction on behalf of Madie Baptist church. I thank the Lord for Bro. Carey Morris hosting the team.

We also had our last MRM team of the year come in June. Wallace Baptist church of Pace Florida came to South Fulton. They were hosted by Johnson Grove Baptist church and worked at the Beulah Land Cowboy church as well as at Johnson Grove. They also conducted canvassing in the communities around South Fulton and the Hop-In area around Alamo, for Alamo Baptist church. They were a great blessing to all they ministered for, and too.

We have just returned from this year's Youth Venture. What an awesome and exciting time we had in serving the people of Muskogee. We had 176 people from 16 churches total, with 15 of them being Beulah's. We also worked alongside 3 of Muskogee's churches, making a total of 19 churches working together for the glory of God! We were able to set all the walls, and, rafters on two of the three cottages. We also completed 5 more construction projects for churches and individuals while there. We conducted 4 VBS with over 175 kids present daily to hear the Gospel! We also conducted 3 BYBC daily with many kids from the surrounding neighborhoods. We also had the privilege to visit over 1500 homes and present the Gospel of John and plan of salvation. This represents over 4500 people! Along the way, people were engaged with faithful witnessing of our missionaries, and we had a total of 31 professions of faith that we know of! Time will only tell of what fruit our Father's Word brings into His fold from the canvassing! We had many more decisions from our own group in our worship service in the evenings. We rejoice that many people, for the first time, shared Christ personally with someone! We had people that became soul winners for the glory of God, and their lives will never be the same again! Others were exposed to witnessing that have never been before. Along with souls being saved and decisions being made in individual lives, we have had churches form relationships for ministry here at home! These are just a few things that we are aware of that our heavenly Father accomplished in His church while we were in Muskogee. It is clear that the relationships of individuals, as well as churches, were strengthened during this marvelous week. Please make it a matter of prayer as we seek direction in next year's trip. We have people already making plans to be a part of it! The tentative date is June 20-27, 2015. Make your plans now, and bathe them in prayer!

I ask you to continue to pray about possible India trip for me on the behalf of our association. Several have encouraged me and contributed in order to help bring about the partnership with this people group. We are still in need of some financial support in order to have the pastor /church planter meetings. Please contact me if you would like to help to bring about hundreds, if not thousands to Christ in India!

I also ask you continue to pray about our vision of having shower trailers available to our churches to use on mission, as well as visiting MRM teams to use while they are here. God is able! Please contact me if you would like to help!
