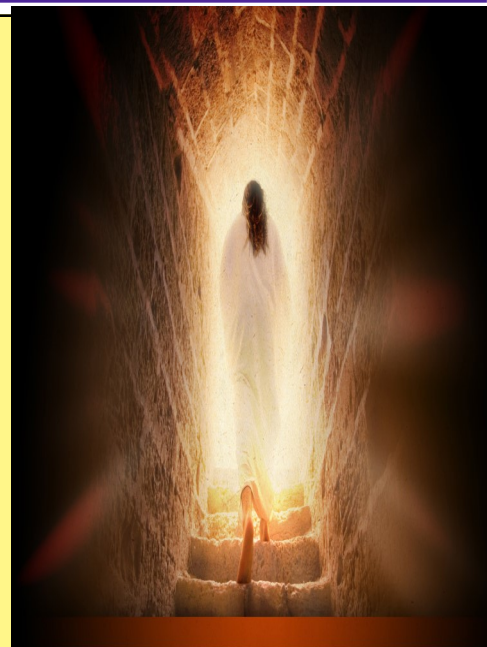
I'm thankful to serve you once again and look forward to working together with you all to further the Kingdom work.

### FACTS ABOUT ANNIE ARMSTRONG

- a lay Southern Baptist leader instrumental in founding WMU in 1888
- born June 11, 1850 in Baltimore, MD and died December 20, 1938 in Baltimore, MD
- for years she worked with orphans—African American—Native American— Chinese Immigrants and indigent women and families
- an extensive letter writer *she wrote 18,000 letters in 1 year* encouraging communication between denominational leaders and missionaries in the field
- she refused a salary and paid her own expenses
- she met with fierce opposition by the male SBC leadership of the day due to her being female
- buried in Green Mount Cemetery in Baltimore, MD with her parents and elder siblings
- was inducted into the *Maryland Women Hall of Fame*
