Bro. Marshall's Message

Jerusalem

Acts 1:8 *But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.*

This can be one of those very misunderstood, misquoted, and misused verses in the Bible. Let's break it down a bit. Jesus, right before he ascended, has told them to stay in Jerusalem until they receive the power of the Holy Spirit. So here we see that he is reminding them that the Holy Spirit must give them power before they can do anything else. That goes for us too. Are you currently walking in the Spirit? Next He says, "...you will be my witnesses...". Many times when we "DO MISSIONS" as believers, we go build something, clean something, paint something, etc. However, we don't see that in scripture. Jesus didn't tell us to "Go therefore and build a school, clean gutters, paint a classroom, etc". He said "make disciples". Now, we must realize that, YES, many times it is necessary to do some things like this in order to gain access and build trust with those we are seeking to disciple. As a matter of fact, we did this in our alternative energy projects when we worked overseas. So, I am not saying, don't help people, but what I am saying is let's make sure that the end goal of everything we do is making disciples. In other words, while you are building, painting, cleaning, caring for people; share the gospel and call people to repentance. That's what Jesus did. Now we come to the end of the verse. "...in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Many people will say that this is ordinal, in other words that you should minister locally, BEFORE statewide/nationwide, BEFORE internationally. However, this is not what Jesus was saying here. He said what he said, do ministry everywhere!

Having looked at this verse, let's do it! September 2-4, 2022 is our Beulah Baptist Association Jerusalem Project. What is this? A way to reach into our communities and share the gospel through caring for people. I am asking that your churches send requests to our office for projects that need to be done around your communities. These could be church members or non-church members who need a room painted, a house cleaned, a yard cleaned up, power washing, a wheel chair ramp, or other things. We will then put together multigenerational teams to do these projects. We need all projects turned in by August 18. Currently we have several projects that need to be done at Life Beat in Tip-tonville, and we are seeking teams to help. The evening of September 2 we will meet at the association office to get our teams together and pray for our assignments. September 3 work will start at 8:00 AM and finish around 6:00 PM if possible. September 4 we will have an evening worship service to celebrate what God did through our time in our communities as we cared and shared with people!
