Imagine, for a moment, that you are in your home, watching your favorite show and your power goes out. What do you do? You grab your phone to report the outage. However, your phone is not working. So, you get on your laptop to see where all the outages are, but the internet is out too. You decide to just go to bed and hope that it all gets fixed before you awake. The next morning you awake with high hopes but nothing has changed. You go to get in the shower before going to work and there's no water. Now you are beginning to worry a bit. You decide to get ready and go to work, you'll pick up coffee on the way. You come out of your home and notice an eerie stillness, but you shake it off and head into work, only to notice that no one is on the roads. You stop to get coffee and the shop is closed. Then you see it...a large hole where your place of employment used to be, soldiers in the streets, military vehicles everywhere and roads blocked. You try to drive to your family's homes to check on them but you are stopped at every turn. Life, as you knew it, has changed.

The area where we lived and served overseas had this happen. I am visiting right now, and am hearing stories of two years without electricity, phone, internet, water, food... They survived on roasted grain (wheat cooked over a fire) and water they collected from their roof or streams. They did not go out unless they had to because they would be killed, raped or taken into military service. They were afraid of any engine sound because of drones and planes bombing their city.

When I began hearing these stories I was shocked and amazed. I was deeply saddened, but each person I spoke to has said, "God has a purpose in everything and I am thankful to be alive."

Now they are a few short months into peace and life is returning. Things are still not "normal", but better. You see, no matter what we go through, God knows. Everything is filtered through his hands even when it makes no sense to us. He promises to be with us at all times and calls us to live life for Him, not for ourselves.
