BRO. MARSHALL'S MESSAGE

WORSHIP

When you hear the word “worship”, what comes to mind? Music? Most people would say music. As a former worship pastor, this has always bothered me. Now, I know exactly what people mean when they say these things, and they do not mean anything negative, but worship does not equal music and music does not equal worship; it is a part of worship! The word worship comes from the old English worth-ship, which means to ascribe worth to something or someone, so when you worship you are showing how much worth you are willing to bestow on the object of your worship. We can do this through music but also through prayer, giving (time and money), serving, reading the Word, etc. We cannot manufacture worship or a worship experience, but we can organize things in a way so as to help people worship. On the flip side, we can make it so people are distracted and cannot worship.

We are created to worship; so how do we do that? I mean what are the proper ways to listen to God’s word preached, pray, sing, etc? The Bible instructs us in this; Exodus 4:31-bowed their heads in worship, Psalm 95:6-kneel, Deut 9:18-lay prostrate, Psalm 47:1-clapping, Psalm 134-lifted hands, Psalm 150-dance, Psalm 32:11-shout and more. Which of these do you do? When do you do them? Everyone worships differently and it is not the posture of the body that is important it is the posture of the heart!

In Psalm 95 we are instructed in various ways of worship. First, we are told to “sing to the Lord” and “make a joyful noise” to him so here the psalmist is inviting us to sing, shout, play instruments etc. The key is to worship him joyfully. The question is, is your worship joyful? Second, we are told that in order to worship him, we are to “come into his presence with thanksgiving”. So, when you come to him, do so thankfully. Third, we worship him because he is GREAT! We are told here that he is a “great king above all gods”. We worship him because no matter what, we can rest in the fact that he is in control! Fourth, we are told to “bow before the Lord our maker”. We are to bow. Is that figurative or actual bowing? It does not matter, but the posture of the heart should be one of “lowliness”, knowing our proper place before God. In conclusion, we see that God wants worship. Are you doing that? Are you singing? Are you thankful? Do you take a posture of reverence? Do you serve him? Are you striving to be more like him each day? He is our Lord, and we must worship him!
