Girmay, a young high school student, heard the gospel from our family over and over again. We told him of how the prodigal son returned to the father and how he could return to the Father as well, but he never seemed interested and after a couple of years, we gave up on him. One day, after several months of not hearing from him, he called me to come to his home. He was so excited and said, "I must learn how to pray. Can you teach me? I now believe all the things you and your family have shared with me. I love Jesus!"

Bilal, an older Muslim man, during Ramadan, heard how Isa (Jesus) was the perfect sacrifice for sin, only prophet that knows the way to paradise and therefore the only way to Allah (God). He was so excited; he could not contain himself and could not wait to get home and tell his family how he now knew the savior of mankind!
